Abdur Razzak's village is situated 25 km far from VARD Eye Hospital, Sunamganj. He has four girls but no son. Three daughters are married and younger daughter is studying in class VI. He has the few paddy lands. He is not able to cultivate his own paddy land due to physical disability. He can't do all household work normally. Other people of his village cultivate his land and give him 50% of paddy and runs his family with great difficulty. Twenty-three years ago, he tore a tendon in his left leg while playing football. Even after treatment, it did not get better and at last the left leg was amputated from the knee. Since then he has difficulty walking and use Crutches for walking. He said that he has a problem in his left eye for a long time. He had blurred vision in his left eye, he could not see far and near objects well.

He came many times to VARD Eye Hospital Iqbalnagar, Sunamganj and doctor examined his eyes. The doctor advised that he has a cataract in his left eye and will need an operation. But he could not get the surgery due to lack of money.

A free eye camp organized by VARD Eye Hospital Sunamganj at Dhonpur Union Parishad under sub-district of Bishwambarpur dated on 2nd May 2023. The eye camp is funded by Human Appeal, UK. He attended the said camp on 02/05/2023 after listening to miking on 01/05/2023. The doctor examined his

eyes and after various tests, it was found that he has a cataract in his left eye. On that day, he was brought to VARD Eye Hospital Iqbalnagar, Sunamganj by VARD own transport and cataract surgery was done in his left eye.

Before the surgery, the vision in his left eye was 6/60. Day after surgery his vision in left eye was 6/18. After one week of surgery, during the follow up at the camp site on last 9th May 2023, our doctor found his vision is 6/12 in left eye that is normal.

Now he can see well with his left eye and can perform common works normally without any visual problems. He said, *"I lost my legs and became despondent. My blurred vision was turning my life into darkness.
